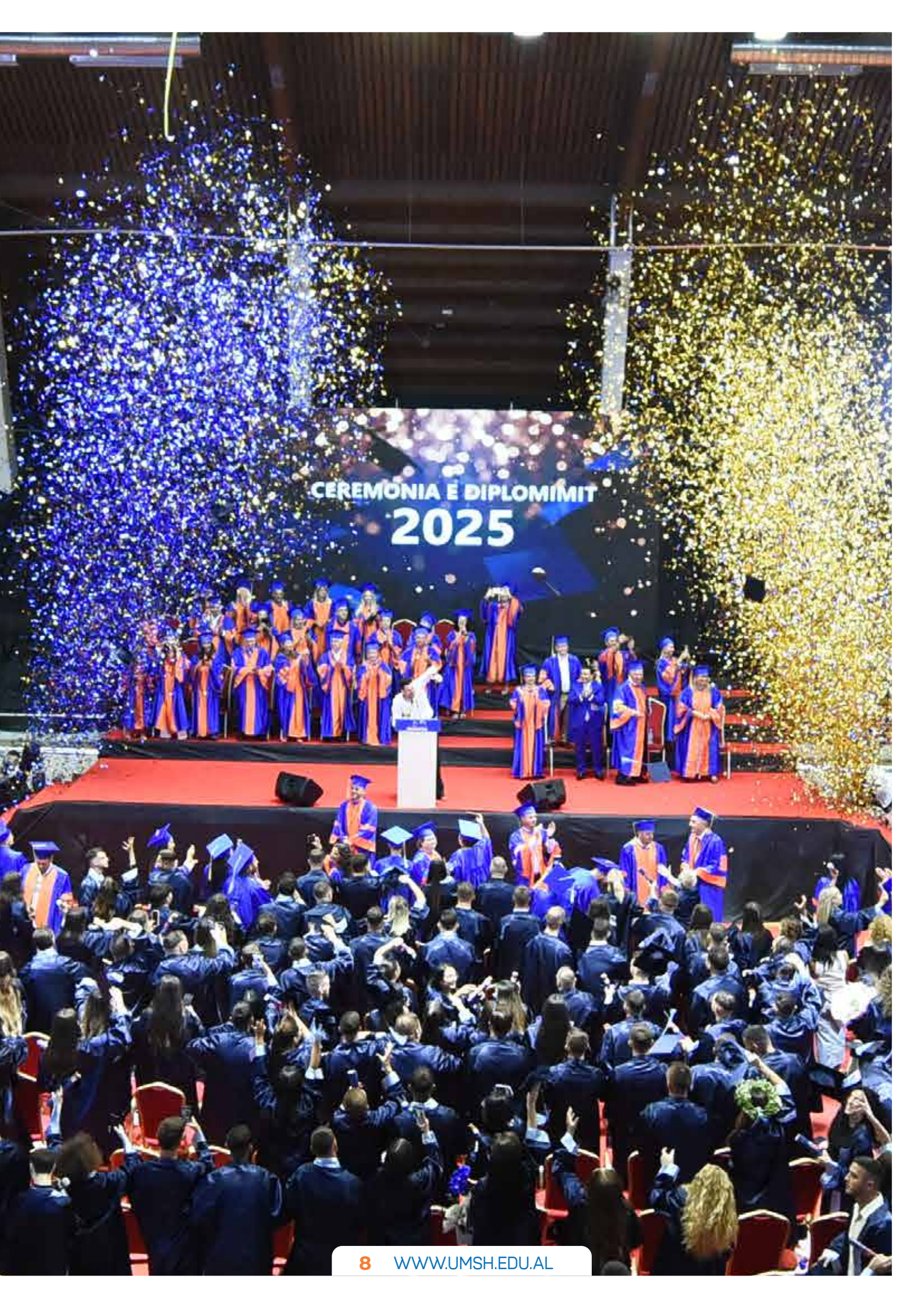

Prof. Dr. Mihal Tase is Dean of the Faculty of Medical Sciences at the Mediterranean University of Albania and currently serves as Supervisor of Medical Services at the Catholic Hospital Our Lady of Good Counsel. He graduated with distinction in General Medicine from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Tirana, in 1980, and completed his specialization in Cardiology with a focus on Hemodynamics in 1987. In 1990, he concluded advanced postgraduate training at Hôpital Broussais in Paris, France, within the Hypertension Unit led by Prof. Pierre Corvol. With over 40 years of clinical, academic, and research experience, Prof. Tase is recognized as one of Albania's leading experts in cardiology, arterial hypertension, metabolic disorders, and internal medicine. He founded and led the Service of Arterial Hypertension and Internal Medicine, which was recognized in 2009 by the European Society of Hypertension (ESH) as a Center of Excellence—one of the few such distinctions awarded in the region. Prof. Tase has held numerous senior academic and leadership positions, including Professor of Medicine at the University of Tirana, Head of the Department of Internal Medicine, Director General of the University Hospital Center "Mother Teresa," and President of several national medical societies. He is a Fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) and has authored and co-authored numerous scientific publications, with over 150 presentations at national and international conferences.

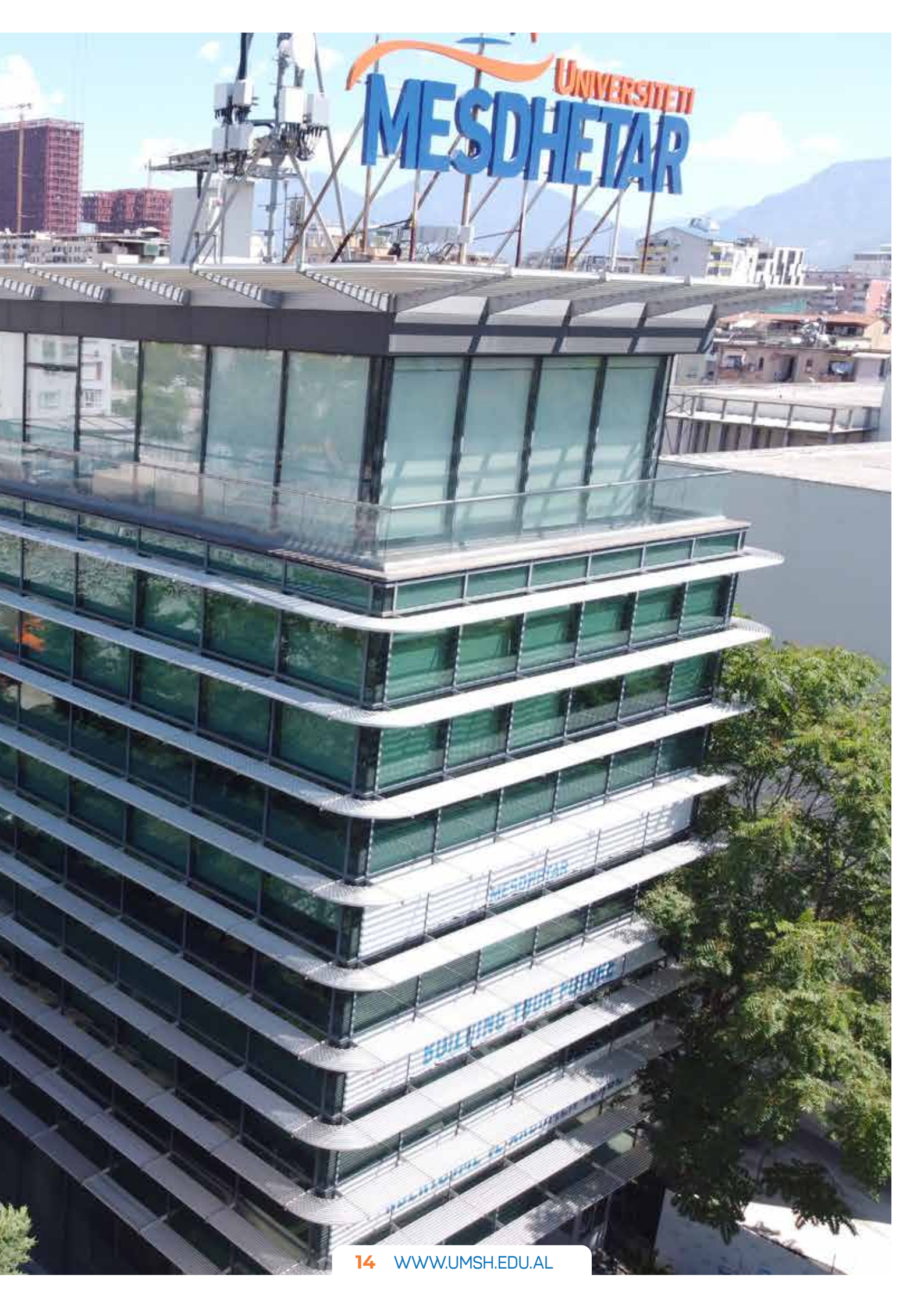

- Photocopy of the applicant's identification document

In addition to the preliminary test, students may undergo an interview in the English language, as part of the academic counseling.

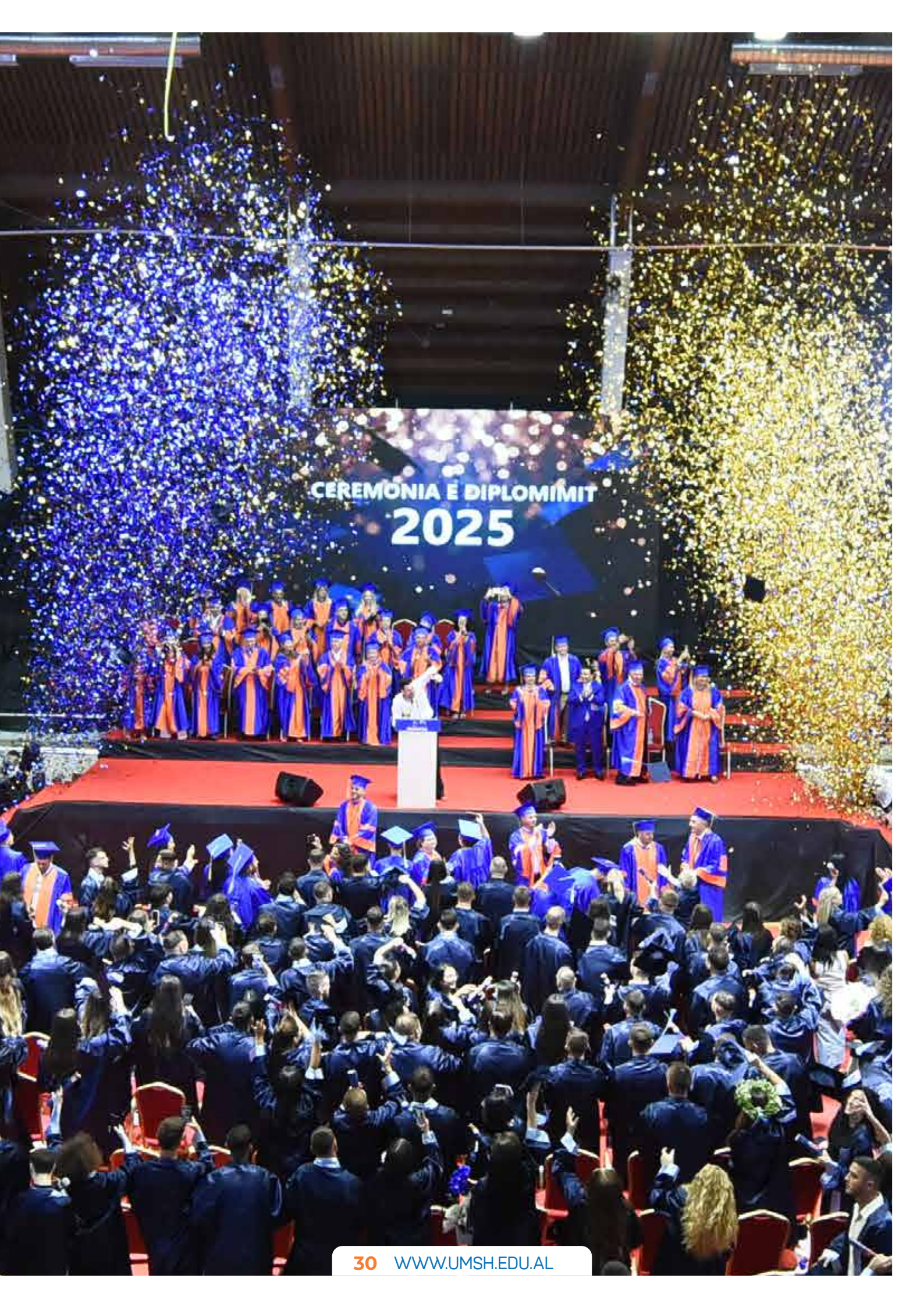
